

PRIVACY POLICY

USInfoSearch.com is a National Information Service provider. We offer nonpublic and public information to carefully screened and certified entities who are legally qualified to receive this information under the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act (GLBA), the Drivers Privacy Protection Act (DPPA), and the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA), among other applicable state and federal laws.

This Privacy Policy covers USInfoSearch.com's web site, and USInfoSearch.com's practices for handling personal information provided to USInfoSearch.com over the Internet by the general public using USInfoSearch.com's publicly available web site. USInfoSearch.com will collect, store, and use personally identifiable information only in compliance with applicable laws.

Information Collection

When you browse USInfoSearch.com's publicly accessible web site, you do so anonymously. USInfoSearch.com collects personally identifiable information from you only if you choose to provide this information to us. In some instances, USInfoSearch.com may collect non-personal (e.g., aggregate or demographic) data through cookies. This information is used to better understand and improve the usability, performance and effectiveness of the USInfoSearch.com web site, as is further described below under "Cookies and Tracking Technology".

How We Use Your Personal Information

When your personal information is collected on USInfoSearch.com's publicly accessible web site, USInfoSearch.com will inform you at the point of collection of the purpose for the collection. USInfoSearch.com will use your personal information only in the way we specify when it is collected unless you consent to a different use. For example, USInfoSearch.com may use personal information submitted in an account application to set up and maintain your account. USInfoSearch.com may acquire other businesses, and other businesses may acquire USInfoSearch.com. If that occurs, the information USInfoSearch.com collects may be one of the assets examined or transferred as part of the transaction. USInfoSearch.com will not permit another business to examine the information USInfoSearch.com has collected without a confidentiality agreement and only to the extent permitted by law. USInfoSearch.com will not transfer the information it has collected unless the recipient agrees to provide privacy protections equal to or exceeding those established by this Privacy Policy.

Cookies and Tracking Technology

USInfoSearch.com's web site may use the standard technology called a "cookie" to collect information about how you use the web site. A cookie is a small data file that is transferred to your hard drive and used for record-keeping purposes. A cookie file can contain information such as the URL you came from, your computer's IP address (i.e., the Internet address of your computer) and domain type (e.g., .com or .org, etc.), your browser type, the country, state and telephone area code where your server is located, the pages of our site that were viewed during a visit, and any search terms that you entered on our site. This information is used for internal purposes only, and we do not link your URL or IP address to any personal information unless you have logged into our web site with a USInfoSearch.com account login and password.

If you would prefer not to receive cookies, you can alter the configuration of your browser to refuse cookies, although it is possible that some areas of our web site will not function properly

if you do so. In particular, you may be required to accept cookies in order to complete certain actions on USInfoSearch.com's web site.

The servers used to store consumer information are maintained in a secure environment with appropriate security measures.
